Curriculum Committee Discussion May 7, 2007

Faculty representatives provided a brief overview of the proposals, noting the core requirements and the links to the other programs. The comments of the Roundtable were presented to the Committee, who agreed that the proposals would be strengthened by the additional notations for the links. It was also suggested that an overview summary be drafted to explain the concept and differentiate the separate programs and note the links. The Committee appreciated the concept of the linked program model and unanimously approved them to move forward for the external review process.
