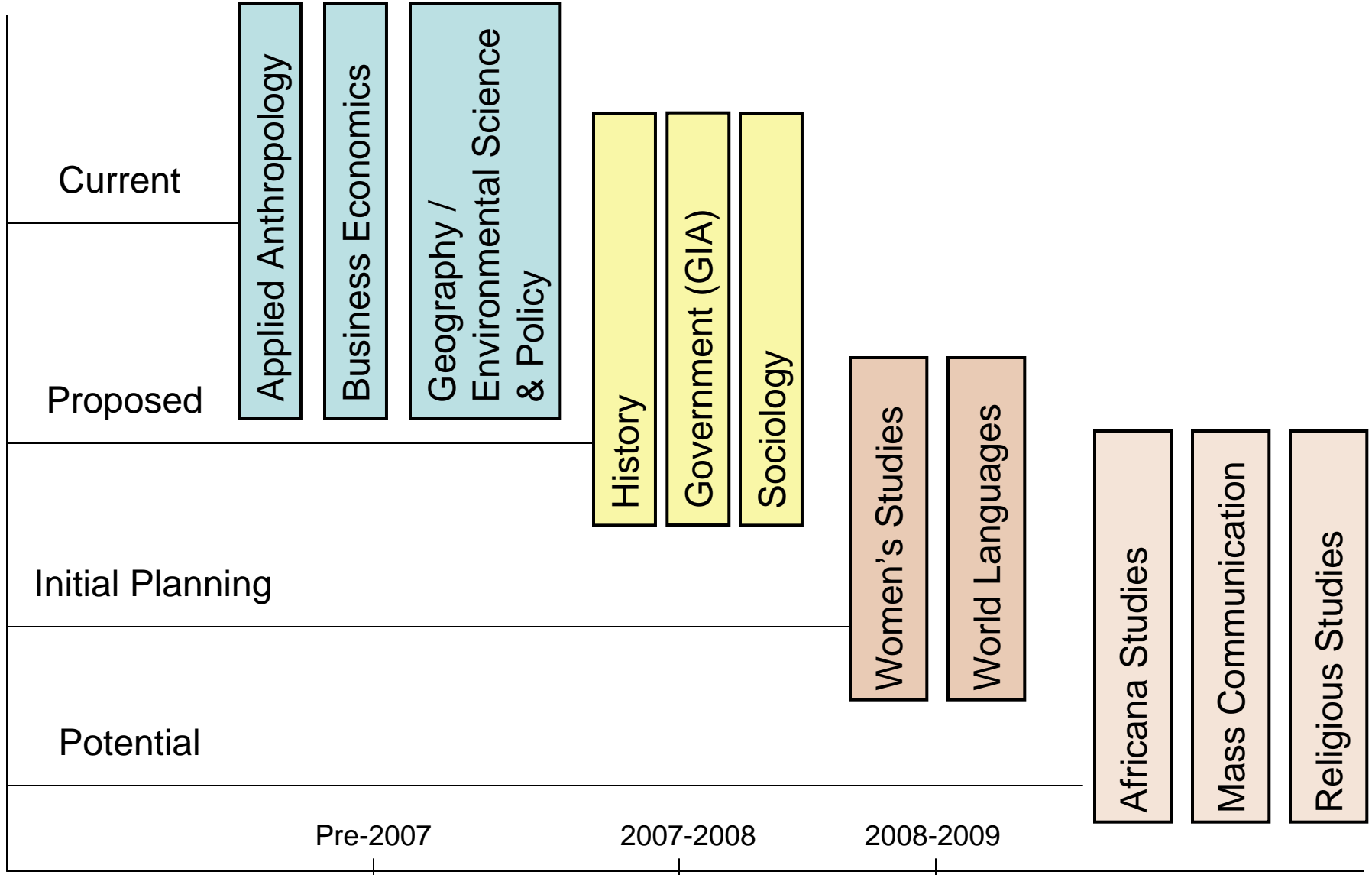

A Multi-disciplinary Global Sustainable Healthy Communities Envelope

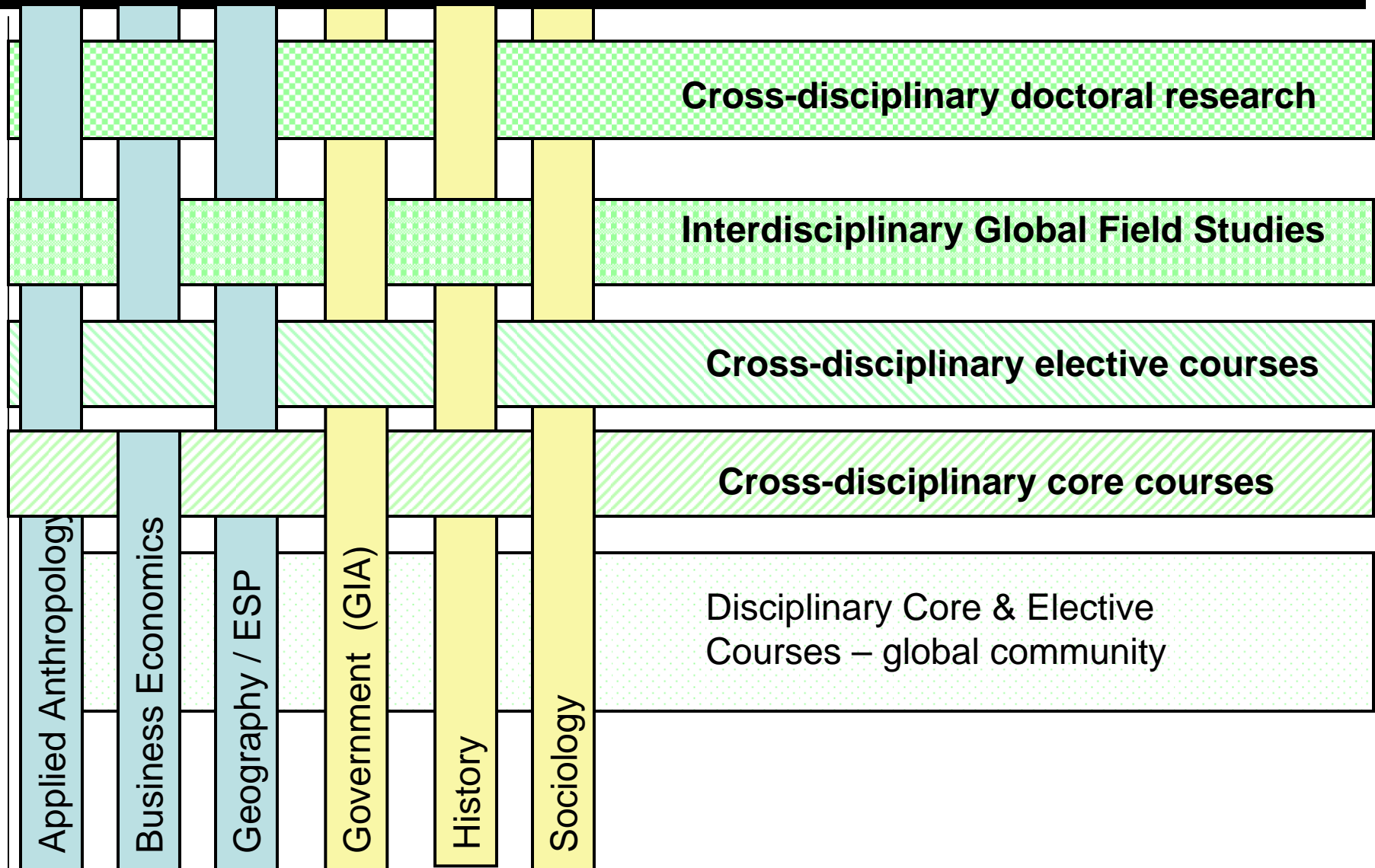
- Core set of courses across existing doctoral programs and proposed programs

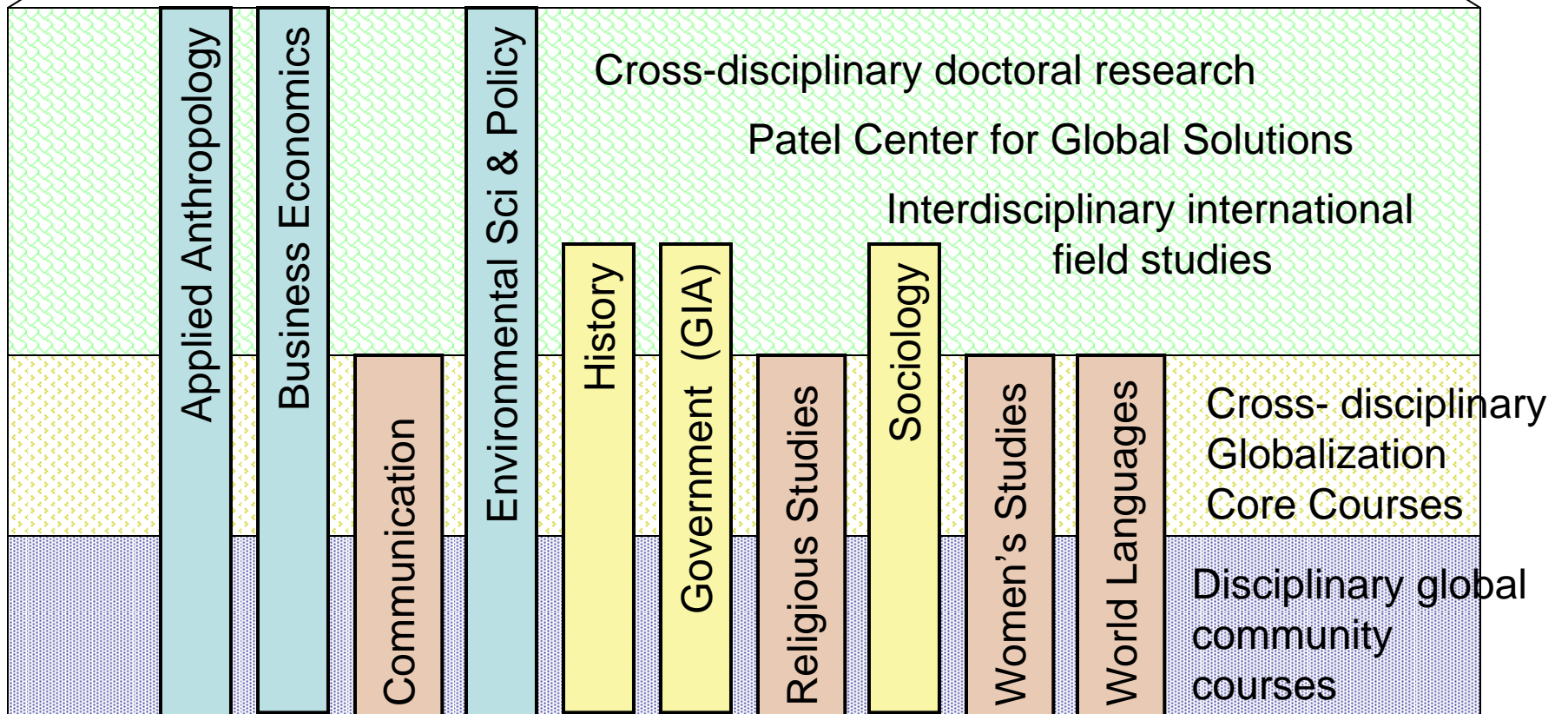
