## Narrative

Ann Winch served USF for over 30 years as a loyal member of the staff and as a volunteer leader in the Alumni Association. She also served as president of THUSFAR, The USF Association of Retirees. She exemplified the very best in loyalty and leadership. Ann was a Charter Donor of the Named Scholars Program and a Life Member of the President's Council. In extending this Fellowship, it was Ann Winch's desire to encourage and enable mature students in their pursuit of a Graduate Degree to promote scholarship and leadership at the graduate level. The Ann Winch Fellowship will award a \$1,000 stipend for the Spring 2010 semester. This is a non-renewable award.

## Eligibility Criteria

Qualified applicants demonstrate the following traits and requirements:

- Enrolled as a Graduate Student at USF during the Spring 2010 semester in good academic standing
- Maintained household or has been in the workforce
- Proven track record of community service
- Strong moral character and strong leadership capacity
- Outstanding academic achievement. Various methods in determining achievement will be used (i.e. GRE/GMAT or GPA, note: there is no specific qualifying score)
- Financial Need

## Application Process

Students meeting the above criteria may submit all of the following on or before October 16, 2009 at 5pm:

1) A completed application form

2) Student's Resume or Curriculum Vitae

3) Personal Statement depicting eligibility for the fellowship

4) Two letters of recommendation
