Initial committee working on general metrics (potential targets):

- First-year retention
- Time to degree
- % completion at 3 years (MS) and 6 years (PhD)
- Debt upon graduation
- Placement
- GA support and type

### TIME-LIMIT EXTENSION DISCUSSION

#### Potentially changing the process:

- Students will still need to the paperwork
- Benchmarks will be critical and evaluated on a semester-by-semester basis
- Lack of progress and lack of support by a major professor may result in the TLE being discontinued
