

Section 4 Graduate Admissions

Application Process (*How it works*)

Graduate applicants are urged to submit accurate and complete information as early as possible. Applications and supporting documents received after the application deadline will be processed for the next available term.

The Graduate Admissions Office and the Graduate Program review your application for admission to the Graduate School. Once the graduate program determines your eligibility for its graduate program they will forward their decision to the Graduate Admissions Office which in turn will issue the official decision. Please note if the graduate program is a Direct Receipt Program (http://www.grad.usf.edu/newsite/direct_receipt.asp). For Direct Receipt Programs application materials should be sent directly to the program (NOT to the Office of Graduate Admissions.) All inquiries regarding application status should also be directed to the program. If you are a foreign graduate applicant, the International Services Office (<http://web.usf.edu/iac/iss/prospect.html>) will evaluate your financial statement after you are admitted to determine your eligibility for a student visa. Each of these offices may request additional documents from you to make a decision.
