



USF CHANGE OF CONCENTRATION WITHIN A GRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM

INFORMATION

For students enrolled in graduate programs that contain concentrations, a change to a new concentration within the Program requires the use of this form. A change of graduate concentration:

- is NOT possible for graduate students in their first semester of study;
- is permissible only for a continuing graduate student enrolled in a Graduate Degree Program who wishes to change to another Concentration within the same Degree Program;
- requires a student to be in good academic standing;
- is up to the discretion of the student's Program and Concentration (note: some concentrations have additional requirements for admission and for degree completion);
- may affect the student's financial aid status.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Student completes Section I and submits the form to his/her current Program.
- The current Program completes Sections II and III retaining a copy of the form for their Department.
- If the Program recommends approval, the Program will forward the original form to the Registrar's Office for final processing.
