

2010 FULBRIGHT-HAYES DOCTORAL DISSERTATION RESEARCH ABROAD FELLOWSHIPS

APPLICATION DEADLINE

All application materials must be submitted through e-grants by **NOVEMBER 15, 2009** so that it can be reviewed by USF.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students must register and submit the application through the e-grants system (<http://e-grants.ed.gov/>). All supporting documents (except graduate transcript) must be attached electronically. The USF Graduate School reviews the application package and submits the application.

ELIGIBILITY

- Is a citizen or national of the United States or is a permanent resident of the United States.
- Is a graduate student in good standing at an institution of higher education in the United States who, when the fellowship begins, is admitted to candidacy in a doctoral program in modern foreign languages and area studies at that institution.
- Is planning a teaching career in the United States upon graduation.
- Possesses adequate skills in the language(s) necessary to carry out the dissertation project.
