The removal of the category of "Elective" courses. As a result, the following "elective" courses are removed from the catalog:

FLE 6167 Cross Cultural Issues in Teaching ESOL (3 credits)

MHS 6420 Multicultural Counseling with Diverse Populations (3 credits)*

SDS 6701 Issues in Diversity (2 credits)*
