Briefly describe why the change(s) are needed and how the graduate certificate will be improved?

The Council on Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs (COA) recently mandated that all accredited fellowships have actual patient clinical training experiences as part of the fellowship. The USF Simulation-Based Academic Fellowship in Advanced Pain Management must comply by June 2019 or it will lose accreditation. To satisfy this requirement, a 3 credit hour clinical course (NGR 6474C Pain Management Clinical Residency) is being added to the graduate certificate.

In addition, the name of the certificate will be changing based on the proposed curriculum and clinical requirements to "Advanced Pain Management Fellowship."
