1. **Selected Topics Courses – 10/3/11**

Dr. Sullins confirmed that Selected Topics should be used for experimental courses and as a temporary solution while permanent course numbers are approved. No need for action at this time.

2. **Program Reviews**

- some of the data is difficult to glean, given that the Infomart system is departmentally based and some of the information includes more than the specific program's information.
- It would be helpful to have a copy of the original proposals for comparison purposes.
- The Graduate School will locate the proposals and post for the Committee's review.
- Dr. Dorn will draft the letter that will be sent to the Programs to provide them with the reasoning for the review and information for what it will entail.
- The Chair will send out the findings to the respective departments.
- The Council will assess any needed revisions to the process in the fall.
